## Railroad Crossing

- The railroad does not have crossing bars.
- Guidelines for crossing New Industries' railroad:
  - Must come to a complete stop at stop signs
  - Check for oncoming trains
  - Only one vehicle may cross at a time
  - Vehicles must stay at least 25' away from the crossing as a train is passing
- No low clearance trailers are to cross over the crossing. They must go to the end of the Railroad Avenue and use the service road that combines our neighboring companies.

## Property Travel

Please proceed with caution as you maneuver through the facility. Be extremely aware of your surroundings whether you are traveling by vehicle or foot. In addition, please adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- 5 mph speed limit
- Execute complete stops
- Rolling Equipment has the right-away
- Designated parking only

## Sandblasting/Painting

No one should be in any paint work areas unless authorized by a NII representative.

## Personal Protective Equipment

Everyone must utilize PPE in all required areas of entrance. Our office facilities do not require any use of PPE; however, upon visiting any yard work site or shop facility the following PPE must be used:

- Hard hat
- Safety glasses
- Steel-toe boots
- Ear plugs

If additional PPE is required, you will be notified by a New Industries employee.

## Signs, Tags, and Barricades

Respect and adhere to posted signs and tags; they are posted to inform you of required actions. Also, DO NOT cross barricades unless authorized to do so. Barricades are placed for your safety as well as the safety of others

## Emergency Response

Emergency situations may arise from matters such as fire, weather, explosions, etc. If you notice:

- Fire or smoke
- Burning odor
- Natural gas or propane
- Leaking containers

### **You should:**

- Notify any staff member
- Evacuate the immediate area

## Fire Protection

Fire extinguishers are located throughout the facility. Familiarize yourself with the location of all extinguishers in the locations within your visiting areas. Only use a fire extinguisher if you are trained and believe it is safe to do so. All New Industries employees have been trained with the general principals of extinguisher use.

## Adverse Weather

If adverse weather arises and becomes a danger to our facility, the Emergency Response Coordinator shall direct all employees and visitors to a predetermined safe area. Everyone should remain in the designated area until an ALL CLEAR is given.

## First Aid

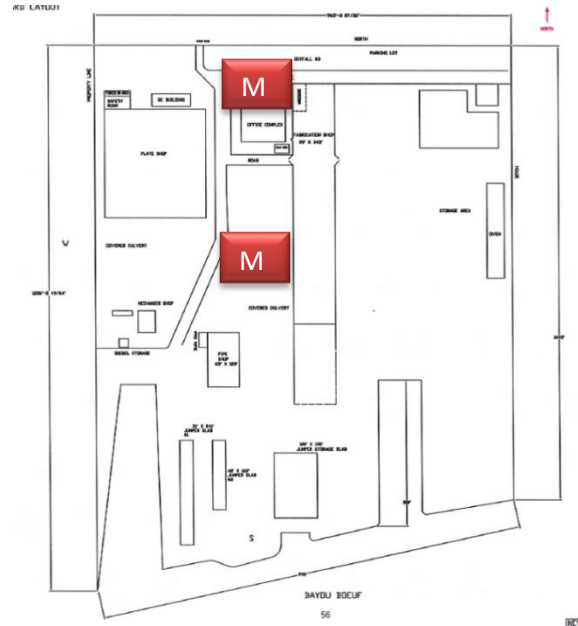
First Aid stations are located throughout the facility:

## Evacuation Procedures

During an evacuation, please follow the listed instructions:

- Notify New Industries representative
- Await instructions from one of our Emergency Response Coordinators or your NII representative
- If an evacuation is issued, calmly proceed to the designated muster station and wait for further instructions.
